This Inventory made this fifteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven and in the twenty first year of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts between Absalom Bailey & Hollan his wife of Southampton County of the one part, and Samuel Cornwall of Newbury County of the other part witnesseth that the said Absalom Bailey & Hollan his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds current money to them in hand paid by the said Samuel Cornwall, the accept whereof they the said Absalom Bailey & Hollan his wife doth hereby acknowledge that they the said Absalom Bailey & Hollan his wife, have granted bargained and sold, Aliened, and released and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell, alienate, and release unto the said Samuel Cornwall his heirs and assigns forever, the certain piece or parcel of Land, situate lying and being in Newbury County, aforesaid, containing by estimation one hundred acres to the same more or less, and bounded as follows vizt. beginning at a black Gun near the main run of Greens branch, a corner of the S. branch of the other, Ledge, thence along the said Cornwalls line, near an east course to a red Oak, a corner tree in Lepe Washingtons line, thence along said Washingtons line near the same Course to a small maple a corner still along said Washingtons line, about a south corner to a pine a corner tree, yet along said Washingtons line, about an east Course to a poplar a corner tree near the main run of the deep branch, thence up the said branch, as it winds to a white oak a corner of Jonathan Cokers line thence along said Cokers line near a west Course to a maple a corner near the main run of Greens branch aforesaid, thence down the main run of said branch to the beginning being the plantation wherein the said Absalom Bailey now dwells. And also all trees, roots, stumps, underwoods, commoners, easements, rights of pasture, purity commodities, advantages, &c. &c. &c. also hereditaments whatsoever to the said piece or parcel of Land above mentioned belonging or in any wise appertaining or in or upon the same growing, happening or occurring, also the revenue & excusing, remainder & remainders, rents and services of the said premises and of every part thereof, and also, all the estate, right title, interest claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Absalom Bailey & Hollan his wife or in and to the same premises and every part thereof, to have and to hold all and singular the said premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof, with all the appurtenances unto the said Samuel Cornwall his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Absalom Bailey & Hollan his wife for themselves and their heirs, the said piece or parcel of land and every part thereof, against themselves & their heirs & against all and every other person & Persons whatsoever to whom Samuel Cornwall his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant & deliver or defend by these presents. — In witness whereof they the said Absalom Bailey & Hollan his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year first above written and signed, sealed & delivered in presence of
