

*This Indenture made this 20th day of November One thousand seven hundred and ninety seven. Between Howell Edmunds Senr. of Cl. =
amilton County and State of North Carolina of the one part, and James
Wilkinson of Southamplon County of the other witnesseth, that the said James
Edmunds Senr. for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred & seventy five
pounds Money, hath bargained, sold & delivered unto the said James Wil-
kinson, a certain tract of land lying on the North Side of Littlehew River in
the aforesaid County of Southamplon, containing by estimation one hundred &
sixty Acres, be the same more or less, and bounded as followeth. On the west
by the said Wilkinsons Beel Plantation, on the South by Littlehew River &
on the east by S. Wilkinsons Dawson tract of land. To have unto to hold
the same forever, which is hereby granted and every part thereof unto said
James Wilkinson, his heirs &c. forever, and the said Howell Edmunds for
himself his heirs &c. with for ever warrant and defend the same against all
and every Person or Persons, whatsoever, In Witness whereof the said Ed-
munds hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the day and year
above written*
