

This Indenture made this twentieth day of September in
 the year of our Lord Christ, one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven
 Between Joseph Washington Senr of the County of Southampton
 State of Virginia of the one part, and Willis Washington of the same
 County and State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas it is agreed
 between Joseph Washington, in consideration of the just sum of Ten shillings
 good Lawful money of Virginia, and for the natural love and affection
 which the said Joseph Washington hath, and do bear unto the said Willis
 Washington his son, have bargained sold, aliened, enfeoffed & confirmed, and
 by these presents with heavy bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff & forever confirm
 unto the said Willis Washington, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract plan-
 tation or parcel of Land, lying and being situate in the County of South-
 ampton State aforesaid, in Stoneyway Parish bounded as follows to wit
 begining at a black Gum, standing in the long branch, a Corner tree.
 thence along a line of marked trees a dividing line of this tract of George
 Washington's (of Letherby) to Lemuel Harts line, thence along the said L
 Hart's line, to a line formerly the line of George Washington's (of George)
 to a pine a Corner tree, thence along the said line to the meadow branch
 to a pine, thence along the run of the said branch to a pine a Corner tree,
 thence along the said branch to the haw branch, thence down the haw branch
 to the mouth of the long branch, thence up the run
 of the said branch to the begining, containing by estimation two hun-
 dred & forty Acres, be the same more or less, together with all houses
 out houses, waters and water courses, mines & minerals, and all other
 the property & possessions thereabouts belonging, or in any wise appertaining
 to have and to hold the said granted & bargained premises to the the
 appertaining, unto the said Willis Washington his heirs & assigns
 forever, and in reversion after reversions, remainder and permanent rents
 & issues for ever thereof, unto every part and parcel thereof unto the said
 Joseph Washington for himself his heirs & executors & Administrators doth
 covenant grant and agree to and with the said Willis Washington his heirs
 & assigns in the following manner (that is to say) that he the said Joseph
 Washington at the time of the signing, sealing & delivery of these presents shall
 fully seige & despatch, of in case to the said bargained premises, in a good &
 free estate in fee simple, and that the same is fully, freely & clearly
 acquitted and discharged of & from all former gifts, grants, debts, attorneyages
 and fealties, and of all from all manner of incumbrances whatsoever &
 that he the s^rd Joseph Washington, hath a good right and lawful authority
 to grant sell and convey the said tract of land and appurtenances in
 manner aforesaid, and with heavy warrant & power defend the same
 against the lawful claim of himself his heirs, Executors Administrators
 & assigns and against the lawful claim of all every person persons
 whatsoeuer or whomsoever, unto the s^rd Willis Washington his heirs & assigns
 In witness whereof the said Joseph Washington hath hereunto mutually
