of the one part, and Williams Click of the same County & State aforesaid
of the other part, WITNESSETH that the said George Glover, Samuel Glover,
Mary Glover, John Kelly and Margaret his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Eighty one pounds current money of the State of Virginia, to
them in hand paid by the said Williams Click, at and before the signing
sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they the said
George Glover, Samuel Glover, Mary Glover, & John Kelly & Margaret his
wife doth hereby acknowledge, also themselves therewith fully satisfied, con-
tented & paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents doth hereby
bargain, sell, alien, & release, forever confirm unto the said Williams Click
his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of Land, lying and being situated
in the said County of Southampton & State of Virginia abovesaid as follows
(to wit,) Beginning at a pine on the side of Arthur's swamp, in fact
Baileys line, thence the said Baileys line, south 80° East, 170 pds to a
Oak, on the side of a small branch, thence up the said Branch to a line
of marker trees, thence the said line to a pine, a corner tree in Samuel
Stoy & James Stoy's line, thence the said Stoy's line to a pine a corner tree in
the said Williams Click's line, thence the said Click's line to Arthur's swamp
hence the various courses of the run of said swamp, to the beginning (which
said land was conveyed to a certain James Cooper by a Deed of
from his father in law, Joseph Cobb, and recorded in the County Court of
Southampton, and sold by the said James Cooper, unto George, Samuel & Mary Glover, by a
