between George Glover, Samuel Glover, Mary Glover & John Kelly &
Margaret his wife, of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia
of the one part, and Williams Vick of the same County & State of Virginia
of the other part, Witnesseth that the said George Glover, Samuel Glover,
Mary Glover, John Kelly and Margaret his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Eighty one pounds current money of the state of Virginia, to
them in hand paid by the said Williams Vick, at and before the signing
sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they the said
George Glover, Samuel Glover, Mary Glover, John Kelly & Margaret his
wife doth hereby acknowledge, also themselves therewith fully satisfied, con-
tented & paid, have bargained and sold, assign, convey these presents doth hereby
bargain, sell, alien, convey, I forever confirm unto the said Williams Vick
his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of Land, lying and being situated
in the said County of Southampton & State of Virginia & bounded as follows
(to wit,) Beginning at a pine on the side of Bathurst swamp, in Jacob
Baileys line, thence the said Baileys line, South 80° East, 170 ft. to a
Oak, on the side of a small branch, thence up the said Branch to a line
of mark oaks, thence the said line to a pine, a corner tree in Samuel
Stony & James Stony's line, thence the said Stony's line to a pine a corner tree in
the said Williams Vicks line, thence the said Vicks line to Bathurst swamp
thence the various courses of the run of said swamp, to the beginning (which
said land was conveyed to a certain James Cooper by a Deed of
Southampton, and sold by the said James Cooper, unto George & Samuel Glover
& thence to the above named, George, Samuel and Mary Glover, by a
former conveyance), containing by estimation two hundred Acres, be the same
more or less, together with all houses, out houses, ways, easements, & other matters
appertaining, with all the estate, right, title, interest, claim and demand of
them the said George Glover, Samuel Glover, Mary Glover & John Kelly & Margaret
his wife. He have and to hold the said bargained premises with every of the ap-
purtenances unto the said Williams Vick, his heirs and assigns forever, unto
the use and behoof of the said Williams Vick, his heirs and assigns forever.
