This Indenture made this sixth day of July in the year
of our Lord, One thousand seven hundred & ninety seven, between
Harry Pope of the County of Southampton Spinish of Mollway of the
parish, Withesheth that the said Harry Pope, for and in Consideration
of the just and full sum of three hundred pounds, Current money of
Virginia by the said Jordan Censon & Joseph Censon of the same County &
City of London, the said Harry Pope, for and in Consideration
of the just and full sum of three hundred pounds, Current money of
Virginia, and delivery of these presents, and the further sum of
fifty seven pounds, Thirteen Shillings & 6^p. Current money of Virginia
delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Harry Pope doth
know by Acknowledgment, and thus acquit and discharge the said Jordan
Censon & the said Joseph Censon, and each of them, and each and
every of their, or either of their heirs, Executors, Administrators, and
Assigns, and himself therewith fully and entirely satisfied contented
satisfied released, set over, delivered & Confirmed, and by these presents
doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, dispose, release, set over, deliver and
Confirm, unto the said Jordan Censon, & Joseph Censon, and unto their
and each of their heirs and Assigns forever, all that plantation messuage
tract and parcel of land, situate, lying & being in the County of South-
ampton, aforesaid on and adjoining Mollway River, near the town of
Jerusalem, and whereon William Rapold now lives, containing by a
late mensuration, about six hundred and twenty Acres, and being all the
lands, which my Father the late Harry Pope, purchased of John
Johnson, and bounded according to the known & reputed bounds thereof, as is
expressed, and declared, by the deed or deeds, for the same, and all the
houses, out houses, Cellars, buildings, woods, ways, waters, & water
courses, Gardens, Orchards, low grounds, profits, Commodities, heredi-
taments & appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging, in any
wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder & remainders
rents, Issues & profits thereof, and all the estate right, title interest claim
and demand of him the said Harry Pope, & his, and to the same, and
every part and parcel thereof, also my two Copper Mine pells, Copper Mines
all the Oak I have now growing, the whole of the said Harry Pope's Stock of
Horses, Cattle, Hogs and sheep, House hold and Kitchen furniture, & other
Stock, of Cash, Goods, Wares, Merchandises and Effects in trade or otherwise
to have and to hold, the said plantation messuage tract and parcel of six
hundred & twenty Acres, of land to the same more or less, & pertain with the
appurtenances, as aforesaid, and all the other goods & Chattels, Goods, Chattels
and effects, unto them the said Jordan Censon & Joseph Censon, their heirs
and Assigns, forever, To the only proper use and behoof, of them the said Jordan
Censon, and Joseph Censon, their heirs and Assigns forever, And the said Harry
Pope, for himself, his heirs, Executors, Administrators & Assigns, the said plan-
tation, tract & parcel of six hundred and twenty Acres, of land more or less
and pertain with all and every of the appurtenances as aforesaid
