 pounds current money of the state of Virginia, to them in hand
 paid by the s^r Joel Clegg at and before the signing sealing & delivery
 of these presents, the receipt whereof the said William Brantley
 & Sarah his wife doth hereby acknowledge, and themselves there-
 with fully satisfied, contented & paid, have bargained sold, aliented
 enfeoffed, & confirmed, by these presents doth hereby, bargain, sell
 alient, enfeoff, & forever confirm, unto the said Joel Clegg, his
 heirs and assigns, a certain tract, plantation, or parcel of land
 lying and being situated in the said County of Southampton
 Parish of St. Luke, adjoining the lands of George Garretson
 James Clegg, Hubin Whifford & Benjamin Jordan, contain-
 ing by estimation one hundred & fifty acres, be the same, more
 or less, described by the most known, ancient & particular bounds
 thereof, being the same tract of land that the said William Brantley
 had to their presents, purchased of Percy Timmons & Reid
 Timmons, perhaps the same of James Clegg, reference to
 their deed & conveyance, will more fully shew the bounds
 To have and to hold the s^r plantation, tract or parcel of land
 & every thing whatsoever belonging unto the s^r Joel Clegg his heirs &
 assigns, to the only proper use and behoef of the s^r Joel Clegg
 his heirs and assigns forever. And the s^r William Brantley
 & Sarah his wife for themselves their heirs & assigns
 to have, plantation or parcel of land & tenements, with
 every of the appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said
 Joel Clegg his heirs and assigns, shall have, will warrant & fa-
 vor defend by these presents, in fee simple, against the
 lawful claim of all and every person & persons whatsoever
 whomsoever, In witness whereof this 10th Brantley Sarah
