 bances whatsoever, and that they the said William Johnson & Becca  
 his wife have a good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the  
 said tract plantation or parcel of land, and every of its appurtenan-  
 ces unto the said Josiah Wick, his heirs and assigns forever, and lastly  
 that they the said William Johnson & Becca his wife for themselves, their  
 heirs, executors, administrators, the said bargained premises & every of  
 the appurtenances, unto the said Josiah Wick, his heirs & assigns,  
 shall and will by these presents warrant and forever defend against  
 the lawful claim of themselves their heirs executors, administrators &  
 against the lawful claim of all and every person or persons
