 bargain and sell, Alien and Conspire, unto the said John Abbott one
 certain tract of land, lying and being in Southampton County containing
 by estimation one hundred Acres more or less, and bounded as follows
 Beginning at a red oak a corner of John Pounds land, thence along
 his line, south twenty seven degrees east, one hundred and forty poles
 to a black oak, thence south thirteen degrees east, forty eight poles
 to a maple, in a branch, an elbow tree in Richard Pounds line
 thence up the branch eighty poles to a pine, thence south eighty
 eight degrees West, twenty four poles to a Turkey Oak, on Robert
 Branches old line, thence north seventy one degrees West four poles
 thence north sixty six degrees West, ten poles thence north seventy one
 degrees West, thirteen poles, thence north seventy seven degrees West
 thirty two, to a small pine, by Proctors Road, thence along the
 said course of Proctors Road, two hundred and forty poles to a
 white oak, in the Peasey Branch, a tree in Richd. Pounds line, thence
 along Richard Pounds line to the beginning. Also all woods, underwoods,
 ways, water & water courses, also the possession & occupation, uninclosed
 remained, rents and services of the said premises & of every part
 therof, and also all the estate, right title, interest claim
 and demand, whatsoever now, or then the s^r Charles Brigg, his wife
 Sarah, Richd. P. & wife Frances, or in and to the s^r premises
 and of every part thereof, to have and to hold all and singular the said
 premises, above mentioned & every part and parcel thereof
