jamin & Barbara his wife doth hereby acknowledge, they the said  
Orrey & Barbara, hath granted, bargained, sold, alienated & confirmed  
& by these presents doth grant, bargain sell and confirm unto the  
said Thomas Hart, one certain tract or parcel of land containing  
by estimation forty acres (or the same more or less) situated
