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This Indenture made this nineteenth day of March in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred & ninety eight Between Edwin Gray, Samuel Kelle, Benjamin Plumb, Thomas Parley, Benjamin Puffer, Peter Georgeygn, John Taylor & James Wilkinson Gentlemen Trustees, as hereinafter mentioned, of the one part, & William Evans & Benjamin Evans of the County of Southhampton of the other part the me both, that whereas a part of the General Assembly of Virginia passed an Act, to establish certain Towns & other purposes; that whereas that Town of Evans adjoining the Courtland in the County of Southhampton the property of Joseph Williamson Esq, should be over and above divided into Edwin Gray Samuel Kelle Benjamin Plumb, Thomas Parley, Benjamin Puffer Peter Georgeygn, John Taylor & James Wilkinson Gentlemen besides to be by them, or a majority of them, laid off into Lots of an half Acre each, with convenient Streets, and established a Town by the name of Evansdale, and whereas the s<sup>d</sup> Act hath further directed that the s<sup>d</sup> Trustees or a majority of them, should proceed to sell the s<sup>d</sup> Lots, at public auction for the best price that could be had for the same, and hath empowered the s<sup>d</sup> Trustees to convey the same to the purchasers thereof in fee, upon certain conditions which may be more particularly known by a reference to the s<sup>d</sup> Act.
