 This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of August in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven between William Cowper of Munfrevsbrough North Carolina of the one part and Thomas Evans of Southampton County Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Cowper for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty five pounds Current money to him in hand paid before the making and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and himself to be therewith fully Satisfied Contented & Paid hath granted bargained and sold Alien'd, enfeoff'd and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargained sell Alien'd enfeoff'd and forever confirm unto him the said Thomas Evans his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the lower end of Southampton County on the head of the Great Marsh Containing by Estimation One hundred and more or Less it being the tract of Land which he the said Cowper bought of Jacob Darden Junr. (Successor for James Loggins's Executors) & bounded as Specified in the said Darden's Deed to him for the same To have and To hold the said bargained Premises with appurtenances unto him the said Thomas Evans his heirs and assigns forever together with all houses out houses Water and Water Courses ways Mines and minerals and all the profits & Commodities to the said tract belonging or in any wise appertaining the
