The Commonwealth of Virginia to William Hines ake
 Blotter to Robert Goodwyn Gentlemen greeting, Whereas Arthur Farmer &
 Nancy his wife, & John Lissimons last & Lucy his wife, have by their
 certain Indenture of bargain & sale, dated the 30th day of March,
 One thousand seven hundred & thirty eight, convey so unto to him
 Apple 10 acres of the County of Southampton, the fee simple estate
 of and in three hecres and forty four Acre of Land, of and in three
 with the appurtenances, lying and being in the County aforesaid, who
 whereas the said Nancy & Lucy, cannot conveniently travel to the Court
 of our said County of Southampton, to acknowledge the same, therefore
 we desire to you power to receive the acknowledgement, which they the
 said Nancy & Lucy, shall be willing to make before you, of the
 conveyance aforesaid, contained in the said Indenture, which is
 hereunto annexed, and we do therefore command you, to go personally
 to the s^r Nancy & Lucy, and receive their acknowledgment of the same
 and examine them privately apart from their said husbands, whe-
 ther they have executed the s^r deed, freely and voluntarily, without
 the persuasion or threats of their husbands, and whether they are
 willing the said Indenture should be recorded, in the Court of our
 said County of Southampton, and when you have examined them
 as aforesaid take their acknowledgment of the said Indenture, that
 you distinctly & truly certify us thence, under your hands & seals.
 returning to us also this court certifying Samuel Kells clerk of our
 Court at his Office, this 21st day of March 1798, and in the 32nd year
 of our foundation. —

 relinquish all right & title, to the Land mentioned in the deed her-

 County Court of Southampton, given under our hands & seals
 this thirtieth day of March 1798. —
