

Williams to Williams
This Indenture made the 1st day of October in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, between Charles of the one part, county of Warrford and state of North Carolina and Solomon Williams of the other part, of the County of Southampton State of Virginia, Witnesseth, that the said Charles Williams, for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred pounds, lawfull money of this state, to him the said Charles Williams in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Charles Williams hath granted bargained sold sole, unto the s^d Solomon Williams, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of Land, containing 400 Acres, more or less, lying in Southampton County the property of the s^d Charles Williams, beginning at the mouth of the beaver dam branch, where it empties into the Cypress swamp, running up the s^d branch, a south course, to the mouth of a small branch, emptying into the beaver dam branch, up the said small branch a south course to the Virginia line, at old Elms Corner, thence along the Virginia line, an east course for miles at Williams's Warts corner, thence, lying in s^d Williams's line, to the Cypress swamp, up said swamp to the first station, together with all the singulair houses, Chimneys, buildings, Stables, yards, Gardens, orchards, Land, tenements, water and water courses, privileges profits appurtenances whatever to the said Land, that the said Charles Williams do warrant and defend the right and title of said Land against the lawful claim, of any person or persons whatever, that the said Charles Williams do give up, make over and confirm the s^d bargain and selling of said Land, and every thing appurtenant thereto, and do give the s^d Solomon Williams, and his heirs or assigns in good and peaceable possession of the same, that the s^d Charles Williams do warrant and defend the aforesaid bargain and selling against the lawful claim, of any person whatever, and for ever do warrant and defend by these presents. In witness whereof, the said Charles Williams has hereunto set his hand and Seal the day before above written.
