This Indenture made the 12th day of Nov^r one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven. Between John Lynam of the first part Joseph Lynam, a trustee specially appointed of the second part, and Priscilla Lynam wife of John Lynam, Penumb and allatila Lynam Children of the s^d Lynam of the third part. Witnesseth that the said John Lynam for and in consideration of the natural Love & affection which he hath and beareth unto the said Priscilla his wife and Penumb and allatila Lynam his Children, as also for and in consideration of the sum of two pounds current money to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Lynam, the receipt whereof the said John Lynam, doth hereby confess & acknowledge; he the said John Lynam, hath given granted, bargained & sold, aliened, conveyed, released & confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain & sell, alien, convey, release & confirm unto the said Joseph Lynam, his heirs executors, administrators & assigns, all that had or part of Land, situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation two hundred and fifty Acres, being the same Land whereon the said John Lynam at present resides, also seven Slaves to wit, Sarah Aggy Joe, Dinah Ethelred, Tom & Allen, two hives to wit one head of cattle all the Stock of Hogs, House hold and Kitchen furniture, plantation utensils and one hundred and fifty barrels of Corn, to have and to hold the said Land Slaves & personal Chattels unto the said Joseph Lynam, his heirs executors administrators & assigns, to and for the use, trusts, intents & purposes herein after set forth, and to and for no other use, intent & purpose whatsoever, that is to say to have, to be kept by the said Joseph Lynam to be applied in the following manner to wit) one third of the s^d Land & premises, of the Slaves, and other personal property, to and for the use of the said Priscilla the wife, for and during her natural Life, and after her decease, then the s^d one third of the Land & personal property to be held to and for the use of Penumb & allatila Lynam the Children aforesaid & their heirs forever, and the one third of the said Land, Slaves and personal property, to wit, the remaining two thirds thereof, in trust, to and for the use, of Penumb and allatila Lynam the Children aforesaid, and their heirs and assigns forever, to be equally divided between them, and the said John Lynam for himself & his heirs his heirs executors, Administrators & assigns, shall and will warrant, and lawfully no other use, intent and purpose whatsoever — In witness whereof the parties aforesaid, have hereunto set their hands and seals, the day and year first above written —
