This Indenture made the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven. Between John Loyer of the first part Joseph Loyer, a trustee specially appointed of the second part, and Priscilla Loyer wife of John Loyer, Bennet Loyer, Matilda Loyer Children of the s<sup>d</sup> Loyer Loyer, of the third part. Witnesses that the said John Loyer for and in consideration of the natural Love & affection which he hath and beareth unto the said Priscilla his wife and Bennet Matilda Loyer his Children, as also for and in consideration of the sum of two pounds current money to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Loyer, the receipt whereof the said John Loyer, doth hereby confess & acknowledge; he the said John Loyer, hath given granted, bargain sold, alien conveyed, release & confirmation, and by these presents hath given, granted, bargain sold, alien conveyed, release & confirmation unto the said Joseph Loyer, his heirs executors, administrators & assigns, all that had or part of Land, situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation two hundred and fifty Acres, being the same Land whereon the said John Loyer at present resides, also seven Slaves to wit, Sarah Aggy Joe, Dinah Ethelred, Tom & Allen, two hives to wit, one head of cattle all the Stock of Hogs, House hold and Kitchen furniture, plantation utensils and one hundred and fifty barrels of Corn, to have and to hold the said Land Slaves & personal Chattels unto the said Joseph Loyer, his heirs executors administrators & assigns, to use for the use, trusts, intents & purposes herein after set forth, and to use for no other use, intent & purpose whatsoever, that is to say to wit, to be holden by the said Joseph Loyer to be applied in the following manner to wit) one third of the s<sup>d</sup> Land & premises, of the Slaves, and other personal property, to use for the use of the said Priscilla the wife, for and during her natural Life, and after her decease, then the s<sup>d</sup> one third of the Land & personal property to be holden to and for the use of Bennet & Matilda Loyer the Children aforesaid & their heirs forever, and the one third of the said Land, Slaves and personal property, to wit, the remaining two thirds thereof, in trust, to use for the use, of Bennet and Matilda Loyer the Children aforesaid, and their heirs and assigns forever, to be equally divided between them, and the said John Loyer for himself & his heirs his heirs executors, Administrators & assigns, shall and will covenant, and lawfully no other use, intent and purpose whatsoever.
