 William Coans of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
 have this day sold and delivered, and by these presents do hereby sell
 give, sell, deliver & confirm unto Wm Pope, the following pro-
 perty to wit, one Negro woman named Cate (and her future
 increase) four head of Cattle, one sow and six pigs, two feather
 beds & furniture, one hair trunk, six Windsor chairs, one P. Tongs
 and shovel, one P. hand Iron, one fine Table (painted) second
 pieces Cuckery, one Iron pot, & one water pail and Tub; for the
 Consideration of one hundred and five dollars, which the said
 Coans, justly owes to the s^r Pope, and for and in the further
 Consideration of one dollar by the s^r Pope, to the s^r Coans
 in hand here paid at and before the executing and delivery of
 these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by
 the said Coans therewith contained & paid, To have and to
 hold the s^r Negro Cate & her future increase, with all and
 every the graven Articles, Stock Goods and Chattels unto the said
 Pope his heirs and assigns, - But nevertheless if the said
 Coans shall well and truly pay unto the s^r Pope, the above
 mentioned Consideration of one hundred and five dollars and
 the further Consideration mentioned in hand paid of one dollar
 and also save and keep harmless the s^r William Pope of a soon
 indenture to Wm L. Blow Sen^r & Co in which the s^r Pope
 became bound by a writing obligatory, bearing date at
 10th 1798, then then the s^r William Pope his heirs or assigns
 shall and will at the request of the said Coans, his heirs &c
 release and Convey by actual bill of Sale, the said Negro Cate
