This Indenture made on the thirteenth day of February in the year of Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight between William Boydlin of the County of Southampton of the one part and Elias Williamson of the said County of the other Witnesseth that the said William Boydlin in consideration of the sum of one hundred Pounds Lawfull Money of Virginia to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledge hath bargained sold and Delivered and by these presents doth bargain sell and Deliver unto the said Elias Williamson and his heirs all that tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton containing one hundred Acres more or less and bounded as follow (to wit) Beginning at a red oak on the road leading to Broadwater bridge on Micajah Holliman's line then along a line of marked Trees to a Maple on Absolom Williamson's line and thence along a line of marked Trees to a Spruce pine a corner tree on the said Absolom Williamson's line and thence along a line of marked trees to a pine on the main road leading to Broad Water bridge then along the road to the Beginning - To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with its Appurtenances to him the said Elias Williamson and his heirs and the said William Boydlin for himself his heirs and assigns Administrators the tract or parcel of Land with its appur.
