At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 10th day of July 1798 - This Indenture was proved by the oath of Simon Baykin one of the witnesses who also deposed that he saw Mr. S. Wills (who is since ^{removed} ~~deceased~~) subscribe his name to the Indenture in presence of the parties as a witness - and at a Court held for the County the 20th of August 1798 This Indenture was further proved by the oath of James Seabell a witness hitherto ~~who~~ deposed that he saw Mr. S. Wills (who is since removed to the Western County) subscribe his name as a witness to the Indenture in presence of the parties and at their request Whereupon on the motion of Mr. Wilkins the Indenture is ordered to be recorded & certified to the Court of Chancery ~~where the land lies~~

This Indenture made this fourth day of January in the year of our Lord Christ 1798 Between Shadrach Newton of the County of Southampton planter of the one part and Bailey Barnes of the aforesaid County planter of the other part Witnesseth that the sd Shadrach Newton for & in consideration of the sum of Sixty five pounds current money of England to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Bailey Barnes before the executing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted Bargained sold Alien'd Enfeoff'd confirmed and made over and do by these presents for my self my heirs and every of them Grant Bargain sell Alien enfeoff and confirm and made over unto said Bailey Barnes his heirs and assigns forever All that right little Interest claim and Demand of in or to one certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation one hundred Acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded by the most known ancient and Reputed bounds thereof Beginning at a mouth of a small Branch on the east side of the White wood Swamp then up the turn of the said Branch South East eight or Pole to a poplar on the north side thereof thence
