This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of November
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven Be-
 tween Eum Scott and Ann his wife of the county of Isle of Wight
 and state of Virginia of the one part and William Washington the County
 of Southampton and State aforesaid of the other part
 witnesseth, that the said Eum Scott and Ann his wife for and
 in consideration of the sum of Nine pounds Current Money
 of Virginia, to them in hand paid by the said William Washington
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the
 receipt whereof the said Eum Scott & Ann - his wife doth
 hereby acknowledge and themselves therewith fully satisfied
 contented and paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents
 doth hereby sell, alien, enfeoff, & forever confirm unto the said
 William Washington his heirs & assigns for ever a certain parcel
 or lot of ground lying and being situated in the Town of
 Jerusalem in the County of Southampton and distinguished
 by the plan of the said Towne by R. E. Pearson containing by Survey
 half an Acre, Together with all houses and Accesories, Gardens,
 Water, Water Courses, Mines and minerals, and all other the
 profits and commodities thereto belonging or in any wise appur-
 tenancing, to have and to hold the said bargained premises
 with the appurtenances unto the said William Washington
 his heirs assigns forever, with the reversion of Reversions, remain-
 der & remainders, Rents, Issues & profits thereof & every part
 and parcel thereof, and the said Eum Scott & Ann his wife
 for themselves, their heirs, Executors, & Administrators the Covenant grant
 and agree to and with the said Mr. Washington his heirs & assigns
 in the following manner (to wit) that they the sd Eum Scott &
 Ann - his wife, at the time of the signing sealing and delivery
 of these presents, are lawfully seized & possessed in and to the said
 bargained premises, in a good & plaine estate in fee simple, and that
 they have a good right and legal authority to sell and convey
 the same in manner aforesaid and that the same, fully &
 clearly acquitted & discharged from all former gifts grants
 & Mergers & from all manner of encumbrances whatsoever and
 that the said Eum Scott & Ann - his wife, hath a good right to sell
 & convey the said Lot & premises unto the said Mr. Washington
 his heirs & assigns forever, and that they will warrant and defend
 the same unto the said William Washington his heirs
