in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight
between Cooper Williams of the County of Southampton ^{parish} and the State
of North Carolina of the one part and Kinchen Williams of
Southampton County and State of Virginia of the other part.
Witnesseth That the said Cooper Williams for and in consideration
of the sum of Ten shillings current money of Virginia but
more especially for and in consideration of the good will love
and affection That the said Cooper Williams hath for and
bears towards his Son the said Kinchen Williams he the
said Cooper Williams hath given granted bargained sold
aliened enfeoffed releas'd deliver'd & confirm'd and by
these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien if off
releas deliver and confirm unto the Kinchen
Williams and to his heirs For ever after all that
Plantation Messuage tract and parcel of Land situate
lying and being in County of Southampton as aforesaid, save in
the occupation and tenor of the aforesaid Kinchen Williams containing
by Estimation Two Hundred & Twenty five Acres of Land be the same
more or less and being the tract & parcel of Land granted to the said
Cooper Williams by letters patents bearing date June one Thoun-
seven hundred and forty and bounded & described as by the said Patent
is expressed and declared and all the houses out houses Edifices buildings
ways waters and watercourses Longrunnes Marshes Meadows
Gardens Orchards profits commodities hereditaments and
appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise
appertaining and the inventions and alterations remain'd and
remaines Herits issues and Profits thereof and all the Estate right
title Interest Claim and demand of him the said Cooper Williams
in and to the same and Every part and parcel thereof To have
and to hold the said Plantation Messuage Tract and parcel
of Two Hundred & Twenty five Acres of Land and Premises with
the appurtenances as aforesaid unto him the said Kinchen Williams
and to his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof
of him the said Kinchen Williams his heirs and assigns forever and
the said Cooper Williams for himself his heirs Executors Administrators
