 for an inconsideration of the sum of Five Shillings in hand paid to
 the said Samuel Calvert, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
 and, as well for the consideration of securing to the said Abbigton
 Jones and Matthew Calvert the sum of Eight hundred pounds current
 money of Virginia which said sum they buy the said Abbigton Jones
 and Matthew Calvert stand security for the said Samuel Calvert,
 in the manner and form following, to wit:—on a bond to Jordan Denson
 and Company for one hundred and seventy four pounds three
 Shillings— a bond to Jordan Denson guardian to Edwin & Elizabeth
 Williams for three hundred and eighty pounds— and a bond to
 Joseph Williams for one hundred and ninety pounds, which in
 bonds are dated the twenty second of March one thousand seven hundred
 and ninety seven bearing Interest from the date, have bargained,
