 payment of the debts herein first mentioned due to Jordan Denson
 & Company, to the guardians of Parvill & Elizabeth Williams, and to
 Joseph Williams's guardian, and the said Albrighton Jones and Matthew
 Calvert are hereby empowered to sue for the s^d judgments, bonds, notes &
 accounts in the name of the s^d Samuel Calvert and the money arising
 from the judgments &c. is made liable for the all costs and expenses in
 collecting the same. And the said Samuel Calvert for himself his
 heirs executor, and administrator with covenant and agree to and with
 the said Albrighton Jones and Matthew Calvert their heirs and assigns
 to warrant and defend the right and title of the aforesaid slaves
 horses, stock of cattle, sheep and hogs, and of the judgments, bonds,
 notes & accounts conveyed by these presents against all, and every person
