And all out houses, Edifices buildings, woods or lands waste, water and water courses profits commodities, & appertinances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions, remainures, and remainures, residue issues & profits thereof and all the estate right title interest and annuity of them the said Tjorne Tjorne and Priscilla his wife of us and to the same or any part a parcel thereof.
