KNOW all men by these presents that I Job Wright of Southampton County Virginia for and in consideration of the just and full sum of Seven pounds five Shillings Current money of Virginia by James Scott to me in hand paid (bonified) the receipt whereof the said Job Wright doth hereby acknowledge I therewith acquit & discharge the said James Scott his heirs and assigns forever, and himself, therewith fully & intirely satisfied, contented and paid hath granted bargained sold & covenanted delivered & confirmed by these presents with grant, bargain sell & covenants deliver & confirmed unto the said James Scott his heirs & assigns forever, one Bay horse, one feather bed & furniture & three Sows with pig, one blade Stock, ten Barrels indian Corn & every thing else that belongs to me To have and to hold the said bargained premises unto the said James Scott his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Scott his heirs and assigns forever, and I the said Job Wright for myself, my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns the said bargain'd premises with all and every part thereof unto him the said James Scott his Heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever against me the said Job Wright my heirs Executors Admin^{rs} and assigns and against all manner of Persons or Persons whatsoever Claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Witnes whereof I the said Job Wright have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of Dec^r 1799 one Thousand seven hundred Ninety seven.
