Glousters tree line thence along his line North one and half degrees East Sixty Six poles to a pine, thence North Twelve degrees East, fifty four poles to a White Oak in John Newsums line thence along the various courses of the said Newsums line to the head of a Branch down the said Branch to the mouth of the same branch to a gum thence a strait line to a pine in William Barnes line then by the s^t Edwards line to a white oak by the side of the Beasy Branch aforesaid thence up the Run of the said Branch to the beginning -- To have and to hold, the said granted, and promises with all the profits, privileges, conveniences and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any way appertaining to him the said Thomas Newsum his heirs and assigns as above mentioned -- To him & his only proper use and behoif, and to the said Benjamin Newsum after himself, his heirs, executors and administrators Covenant & agree that Inwarrant and forever before the right & title of the said Tract or parcel of land unto the said Thomas Newsum and to his heirs & assigns forever, against the lawful claims or demands of any person or persons as above mentioned I M witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day above
