 other part, Witnesseth that the said Jeremiah Bell for and in consideration
 of the sum of three pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid
 before the making and delivery of the said William Butts the receipt whereof
 the said Jeremiah Bell doth hereby acknowledge and himself fully contented
 Satisfied and paid hath given granted bargained sold aliened conveyed &c
 conveyed and conveyed and by these presents doth for himself his heirs &c
 and assigns fully fully and absolutely give grant bargain sell
 convey and confirm unto the said William Butts his heirs &c
 and assigns forever one certain parcel or
 tract of land and one great mill on the River in and situated
 Lying and being in the County of Southampton and the High Side of
 Kitterway River containing Two acres one acre on the South Side of the said Swamp
 bounded by Arthur Giffords Line and the said River on the other on the
 South side of the said Swamp and bounded by the said River and Island
 both joining the Mill with all the house mill water water courses
