To all persons to whom these presents shall come Know ye that I John Ryfleck of the County of Southampton for divers good causes and Considerations me thereto moving Have emancipated and set free & by these presents do emancipate and set free a Negro man called Aaron about forty two years old whom I have heretofore held as a Slave And I do for myself my heirs Executors Administrators relinquish all right title claim or interest either to his person or any property he may have after acquisition in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 28th day of May 1798
