

This Indenture made this 25<sup>th</sup> Day of April in the Year of our Lord 1798. between Ann Norworthy of the County of Southampton of the one part & John Crumpler Sen<sup>r</sup> of the aforesaid County of the other part (Witneseth) that the said Ann Norworthy for the Consideration of the Love & affection she bears to the said John Crumpler as well as for the sum of one Dollar to her in hand paid by the said John Crumpler. The receipt whereof the said Ann Norworthy doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the said John Crumpler his Heirs &c. Hath granted bargained & sold & hath by these presents granted bargain & sell unto the said John Crumpler three feather beds & furniture four Chests 2 trunks, 4 Tables, 11 Chairs, 2 Woolen wools, 1 Linen Dr<sup>r</sup>, 1 Plate, 4 Iron posts, two frying pans, 6 porcelin Dishes, 5 basins, 14 plates, 2 pair fire Tongs, one Kneec. 4 Castle, 3 Sheep, 37 Eggs, one Apple Mill, one Still, 15 Bars of Corn, one Loony, 4 Hags & Harness, 3 Axes, 1 Hatchet, 3 Horsing Boxes, 1 Gaveling Dr<sup>r</sup>, 1 Iron Weize, 1 Auger, 1 Gauge, two hogheads, ten Bars of Corn, 8 bottles, 1 Star Parade, 4 guges, 4 Cow Hides, To have and to hold the above mentioned Articles to him the said John Crumpler his Heirs and Assigns forever and the said Ann Norworthy for her self her Heirs & Assigns & adm<sup>t</sup> with by these presents warrant & send unto the said John Crumpler his Heirs & Assigns the above mentioned articles against the Claims of all persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof the said Ann Norworthy hath hereunto set her hand & affixed her Seal the Day & Year above mentioned.
