 bears to the said John Crumplea as well as for the sum of one Dollar. To her
 in hand paid by the said John Crumplea. The receipt whereof the said
 Ann Kinsworthy doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the
 said John Crumplea His Heirs &c. Hath granted bargained & sold & with by
 these presents grant bargain & sell unto the said John Crumplea three feather
 beds & furniture four Chests 2 trunks, 4 Tables, 14 Chairs, 2 Wooden stools, 1
 Iron St^d, 1 safe, 1 Iron pot, two frying pans, 6 pewter Dishes, 5 basons,
 14 plates, 2 Iron fire Tongue, one Horse, 4 Cattle, 3 Sheep, 37 Hogs, one Apple
 Mill, one Mill, 15 Barre^s, one Scon, 4 Sacks & Harrows, 3 Axes, 1 Hatchet,
 3 Weaving Bees, 1 Grinding St^d, 1 Iron wedge, 1 Auger, 1 Gauge, two hoop shears,
 ten Barre^s of Iron, 8 bottles, 1 Side Saddle, 4 gags, 4 Saw Hides, 10 haws
 and to hold the above mentioned Articles to him the said John Crumplea, his
 Heirs and Assigns forever and the said Ann Kinsworthy, for herself her Heirs
 Executors & Admin^{rs} with by these presents Warrant & vend unto the said John Crum-
 plea His Heirs & assigns the above mentioned articles against the Claims of all
 persons whatsoever. In Witnes^s whereof the said Ann Kinsworthy, hath
 hereunto set her hand & affixed her Seal the Day & Year above Mentioned.
