This Indenture made this Sixteenth day of August in
the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and Ninety eight
Between Willis Woolley and Mary his Wife of the County of Gates
State of North Carolina of the one part and William Washington of
the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part
Witnesseth, that the said Willis Woolley and Mary his Wife
for and in consideration of the just and full sum of Forty five
pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the
said William Washington at or before the sealing and delivery of
of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and they
the said Willis Woolley & Mary his Wife, with thereof acquit and
discharge, the said William Washington his heirs and assigns
they the said Willis Woolley and Mary his wife hath granted
bargained and sold, and by these presents with hereby bargain sell
alien, enfeoff, release set over, and forever confirm unto the said
William Washington or his heirs or assigns forever one certain Lot
or half acre of Land, lying and being situated in the Town of Townes
in the aforesaid County of Southampton, and distinguished by the plan of
the said Town by Number twelve (12) and bounded, as follows
(cont'd) Beginning at the Southwest Corner of No 11, thence along the said
Lot 40 feet 9 inches to Scott's Land, hence along Scott's Land
by the Town line 40 feet 9 inches to the Cedar street thence along the
Cedar Street 237 feet 9 inches to the Main street, thence along the
Main street 40 feet 9 inches to the beginning, Together with all houses,
out houses, Gardens, waters, Commotibilities & Privileges thereunto belonging
or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the said lot
or half acre of Land unto the said William Washington his heirs and
assigns forever, with the reversion and reverences remainder and remainder,
Balts, Spous & Heirs thereof, and every part and parcel thereof, with all
the estate right, Title, Interest, Claim and demand of them the said
Willis Woolley & Mary his wife, their heirs & assigns and the said
William Washington his heirs & assigns, that at the time of the
signing sealing & delivery of these presents they have a good right &
legal authority to sell and convey the said lot or half acre of
Land, with every of the appurtenances aforesaid unto the said
William Washington his heirs and assigns, and that they the said Willis
Woolley and Mary his wife for themselves their heirs executors, administrators
and assigns unto the said William Washington his heirs & assigns forever
the said lot or half acre of Land & premises with every of the
appurtenances shall and will warrant and forever defend in fee
Simple against the lawful Claim of all and every person and
persons whatsoever & whomsoever In Witness whereof the said
Willis Woolley & Mary his wife has hereunto set their hands
