

This Indenture made this twentieth Day of March
 anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and Ninety eight
 Between, Edwin Gray James Wilkinson, Samuel Hills, Benjamin
 Blunt, Thomas Ridley, Ben. Roffin, Robert Goodwyn & John Taylor
 Gentlemen Justices in a majority of them as appointed by act of Assembly
 of Virginia bearing Date the seventeenth Day of December anno Domini 1796
 for the purpose of laying off a Town by the Name of Jerusalem on the
 lands of Joseph W. Scott adjoining the Courthouse of Southampton
 County, of the one part & Joshua Frost of the other, witnesseth that the
 said trustees as aforesaid for and consideration of eleven pounds, twelve
 shillings current money of Virginia to be paid by the said J. Frost
 pursuant to the ^{opinion} act to the said Joseph W. Scott do lay out sell and
 alien & convey unto the said J. Frost & his heirs forever one lot or parcel
 of Land lying and being in the said Town of Jerusalem bounded as follows
 and bounded as follows Blk^t. beginning at the South East corner of No^r 7 on the
 west side of the main street thence along the Main street Ninety feet
 four inches to Scott's land (since bought by Joshua Frost) thence along
 the said line two hundred & thirty seven feet nine inches to the South
 East corner of N^r 9 thence along the line on the east side of N^r 9, ninety
 feet four inches to the South west corner of N^r 7 thence to the beginning
 containing one half of an acre as laid off by the commissioners
 To have and to hold the said lot, a parcel of land with the appurtenances
 thereunto belonging to the said J. Frost and his heirs forever, and the said
 J. Frost with covenant & agree with the said trustees in the manner &
 form following Ditz^t that said Frost or his heirs shall & will build
 on the said lot, a dwelling house sixteen feet square at least with a
 brick or stone chimney to be finished fit for habitation in ^{years}
 from the date of these presents & also as punctually pay the money arising
 from the sale of the said lot, to the former proprietors thereof or their legal
 representatives & the said trustees do covenant & agree to & with the said
 Frost & his heirs well & truly to perform all and every the covenants &
 agreements which on their parts by the true intent & meaning of
 these presents they ought to perform, & that the said J. Frost & his
 heirs only may peaceably & quietly enter upon have, hold, possess, &
 enjoy all the premises with the appurtenances above mentioned provided
 the said Joshua Frost will comply with the aforesaid covenant &
 agreement but should the said Frost fail to build a house of the
 above description then the said trustees shall immediately enter
 into and make sale of the aforesaid lot pursuant to the above act
