name now dead, and to my use, to ask demand sue for levy recover and receive
all such sums or sums of money, Debts debts to Goods wares and accounts, &
other Demands whatsoever, which are or shall be due, owing, payable, &
belonging to me or retained from me, any manner of way or means
whatsoever, by giving & granting unto my said Attorney by these
presents my full and whole power and authority in and about the
premises, to have, use and take, all lawful wages and means in my name
in the recovery thereof; and upon the receipt of any such Debts, Sums or
sums of money, arrears or other sufficient discharges for me, in my
name to make seal, and deliver, and generally all and every other act
and acts, thing & things in the Law, whatsoever for me and in my name to
do, execute a Deed or Deeds and perform as fully and amply to all intents
and purposes, as I myself might or could do if I was personally
present, or as if the matter required more special authority, there is here
