This Indenture made this 21st day of December 1797
between William Edmunds & Edmund Turner Commissioners of the one
part, and Jacob Turner of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Commissioners
in behalf of the orphans of John Coggins dec^d and for the consideration
of the sum of forty pounds two shillings to them in hand paid by the
Jacob Turner the receipt whereof the said Commissioners doth hereby
acknowledge have granted bargained and sold unto the said Jacob Turner
his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of Land, lying and being
in the county of Southampton containing by estimation seventy five
acres of land be the same more or less and bounded as follows.
Beginning at a hickory a corner tree of Edmund Turners land and John
Westhookes then on Westhookes line S. W. to a small branch. Then
down the run of the said branch unto the pine pole branch then down the
run of the said branch to Edmund Turners line then along the said Edmund
Turners line an east course to the beginning together with all houses
orchards woods timbers ways waters water courses privileges &c. Reserving
one third part of the said land to the wife of William Palmer who is
mother to the said orphans children of the said dec^d during her life which third
part has lately been bounded and assigned to her to have and to hold the said
granted land and premises to him the said Jacob Turner his heirs and assigns
in full and whole of all claims whosoever for this his special appointee
