

This Indenture made this Eighteenth day of October
 In the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred Ninety and seven Between
 Nelson Synce John Synce Joshua Synce Doresey Synce Elisha Synce John
 Bryant and Deborah his wife and Edith Synce of the County of Southampton
 and parish of Netoway & John Figueres and Feidly his wife of the County
 of Barfild and State of North Carolina of the one part and Matthew Bulls of
 the County of Southampton and parish of Netoway of the other part Witnesseth
 that the said Nelson Synce John Synce Joshua Synce Doresey Synce
 Elisha Synce John Bryant and Deborah his wife Edith Synce John
 Figueres and Feidly his wife for and in consideration of the cash and full
 sum of fifty pounds Current money of Virginia by the said Matthew Bulls to them in
 hand paid before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
 they the said Nelson Synce John Synce Joshua Synce Doresey Synce Elisha Synce
 John Bryant and Deborah his wife Edith Synce & John Figueres and Feidly his
 wife do hereby acknowledge and therof acquit and discharge the said Matthew
 Bulls his heirs and assigns forever and themselves therewith fully and entirely satis-
 fied contented and pacified they the said Nelson Synce John Synce Joshua Synce
 Doresey Synce Elisha Synce John Bryant and Deborah his wife Edith Synce
 John Figueres and Feidly his wife hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed
 released intowed delivered and confirmed and by these presents with grant bargain
 sell alien enfeoff intow delivered and confirmed unto the said Matthew Bulls
 and to his heirs and assigns forever All that Messuage tract and parcel of land
 which was devised to me the said Nelson Synce by the last will and Testament of my
 Father Nelson Synce and being all the Lands which was devised to me the
 said Nelson Synce by my Father containing by estimation one hundred Acres be-
 lie same more or less and bounded as follows (To wit) Beginning at an
 live on the south side of Black water Swamp (or river) a cypress tree in
 Doresey Synces line thence a line of marked trees to the edge of the high ground
 then the edge of the high ground to the little run thence up the said run to a
 pine a cypress tree in Joseph Shotters line thence a line of marked trees to a
 Dogwood in the tough Branch thence the run of said branch to the said
 Blackwater Swamp (or river) and from thence to the beginning containing
 as aforesaid one hundred Acres of Land be the same more or less and all the
 houses out houses edifices buildings orchards woods ways water and water-
 courses profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same
 belonging in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remain-
 and remainors unto Synce and his heirs forever
