

This Indenture made this 17<sup>th</sup> day of November in  
 the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight Between  
 Melchizedek Pitman of Southampton County of the one part and John H. Pond  
 of the opposite County of the other part witnesseth that the said Melchizedek  
 Pitman for and in consideration of the sum of sixty six pounds to him in  
 hand paid by the said John H. Pond the receipt whereof the said Pitman doth here  
 by acknowledge to the said Pitman shall grantee bargained and sold Melchizedek  
 and conforme unto the said John H. Pond his heirs and assigns forever one certain  
 tract or parcel of Land containing eighty Eight Acres by the same more or less  
 situate lying and being in the County of Southampton on the south side of  
 round hill swamp and bounded as follows - Beginning at a cor. white oak in Steeple  
 James line thence along s. E. Ponas line Northly 140 P. a cor. white oak  
 in Benj. Dross line hence along s. E. Dross line N. 42 E. 50 P. a cor. pine thence  
 S. 69 E. 48 P. a small branch a cor. Maple thence up s. E. branch to the fork, thence  
 up the east prong to a pine in the head of s. E. branch thence a line of new  
 marked trees due south 110 P. to s. E. Francis line a pine thence a long Francis  
 line to the begining containing 88 Acres and also all trees and woods whatsoever  
 commons commoners of pastures profits communitie advantages Endements  
 & Incumbrances whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of Land above mentioned belonging  
 or any ways appertaining or in or upon the same growing happening or arising by  
 also the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents & quit-rents of the  
 said premises & of every part & parcel thereof & also all the Estate right Title  
 interest & claim I demand whatsoever of him the said Melchizedek Pitman  
 of me to the said premises & of every part thereof To have & to hold all &  
 singular the said premises above mentioned & every part & parcel thereof  
 with the appurtenances unto the John H. Pond his heirs & assigns to the only  
 user use & behoef of the said John H. Pond his Heirs & assigns for ever & the  
 Melchizedek Pitman for himself & his heirs the said tract of land & every  
 part thereof against himself & his heirs & against all and every other person  
 & persons whatsoever to the said John H. Pond his heirs & assigns shall & will  
 remain & forever after by these presents. In witness whereof I have here-
