This Indenture made this 19<sup>th</sup> of November in the Year of our Lord 1798 — Between Robert Booth & wife his wife of Southampton County of the one part and Donalason Potter of the County of St. George of the other part witnesseth, that the said Robert Booth for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and seventy five pounds current Money of Virginia to him or him paid by the said Potter the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained sold aliened enfeoffed, and confirmed, and by these presents doth bargain, sell aliened, enfeoffed and confirm unto the said Donalason Potter his heirs and assigns forever one tract or parcel of Land, lying and being in the County of Southampton and Parish of Totmon containing one hundred & Eighty acres more or less and is bounded as followeth to wit, Beginning at a Post place in the Hopkin Swamp adjoining Thomas Harts Land, thence Northwest along the said Harts line to a corner at a lightwood Post in Haagraves line, thence North East to a corner point in the said Haagraves line, thence Northwest along the said Haagraves line to a black oak on the said Haagraves line, thence North along the said line to a corner point in Rogers line, thence East along the S<sup>E</sup> Rogers line to a corner lightwood post in inclusion line, thence southwest along the S<sup>E</sup> Inclusion line to a corner point in Thomas Woods line, thence Northwest along the said Woods line to a white oak in the head of the Hopkin swamp thence down the said stream to the beginning. Together with all woods, waters, water courses, profits & advantages to the same belonging the inclusions and ~~remainders~~ and of every part thereof — To have and to hold the said 164 acres and every part thereof unto the said Donalason Potter his heirs and assigns forever and the said Robert Booth unto himself, his heirs & executors and administrators and agrees and with the said Potter his heirs & assigns that the said Robert Booth his heirs and assigns the above 164 acres — with all its appurtenances unto the said Potter his heirs & assigns against him the said Robert Booth his heirs & assigns all other persons whatsoever shall & wills warrant and forever defend by these presents. At witness whereof the said Robert Booth hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written.
