This Indenture made this 19th of November in the Year of our
Sua 1798. Between Robert Broth & Phoebe his wife of Southampton County,
of the one part an Donaldson Potter of the County of Sussex of the other part
Witnesseth, that the said Robert Broth for and in consideration of the sum of one
hundred and seventy five pounds current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid
by the said Potter his Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained
sold, aliened, conveyed, and confirmed, and by these presents doth bargain, sell, aliened,
conveyed and confirmed unto the said Donaldson Potter his heirs and assigns forever
one tract or parcel of Land, lying and being in the County of Southampton and
Parish of Netterway containing one hundred & eighty & three acres more or less and is
bounded as followeth to wit, Beginning at a Poplar in the Freshin Swamp adjoining
Thomas Hawks Land, thence northwest along the said Hawks line to a corner
at a lightwood Post in Hargraves line, thence North East to a corner pine in the
said Hargraves line, thence Northwest along the said Hargraves line to a black
Oak on the said Hargraves line, thence North along the said line to a corner pine in
Hogers line, thence East along the S. Rogers line to a corner lightwood post in Jackson
line, thence Southwest along the S. Jackson line to a corner pine in Thomas
Hawks line, thence Northwest along the said Hawks line to a white Oak in the
head of the Freshin Swamp thence down the said swamp to the beginning. Together with
all woods water & other Courses, profits & advantages to the same belonging the succession
and ~~revenues~~ ^{rents} and of every part thereof. To have and to hold the said 184
Acres and every part thereof unto the said Donaldson Potter his heirs and assigns
forever and the said Robert Broth with for himself, his heirs & assigns, and with
covenant also agree to and with the said Potter, his heirs & assigns that the said
Robert Broth his heirs and assigns the above 184 Acres — with all its appurte-
nances unto the said Potter his heirs & assigns forever against him the S. Broth
his heirs & assigns, all other persons whatsoever, shall & lawfully warrant and
forever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof the said Robert Broth
hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above
written.
