The Commonwealth of Virginia to Charles Briggs Jr. & Edmund Tyler Gentlemen Justices of the Peace of this County greeting wheras Robert Booth Phoebe both his wife have by their certain Inventures of Bargain and Sale under this 19<sup>th</sup> day of November 1798 conveyed unto Donaldson Petrie of the County of Suffolk in the sumpted estate of ana in 164 acres more or less with the appurtenances lying and being in the County of Isle of Wight and wheras the said Phoebe cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County to acknowledge the same therefore we do give to you power to receive the acknowledgement which the said Phoebe shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Inventory which is hereto annexed and so as herefore command you to go personally to the said Phoebe and receive her acknowledgement of the same ana examining her privately & apart from her husband whether she hath executed the said sum freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or threat of her sd husband and whether she is willing the said Inventory should be record in the Court of our said County and when you have examined her as aforesaid and taken her acknowledgement of the said Inventory bid you distinctly and openly certify us thereof with the said Inventory annexed witness Sam Kello Clerk of our said Court at his office the 19<sup>th</sup> day of November 1798 ana in the 23<sup>rd</sup> Year of the Commonwealth
