his wife have by their certain Indenture of bargain and sale dated this 19th day
of November 1798 conveyed unto Donaldson Petter of the County of Sussex in the
first simple estate of and in 184 acres more or less with the appurtenances lying
and being in the County of ~~Stafford~~ ^{Stafford} and whereas the said Phibe cannot conveniently
be brought to the Court of our said County to acknowledge the same herefore we do
give to you power to receive the acknowledgements which the said Phibe shall be
willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture
which is hereto annexed and as we are therefore commenda you to go personally to the
said Phibe and receive her acknowledgements of the same and examine her privately &
apart from her husband Whether she hath executed the said deed freely and volun-
tarily without the persuasion or threat of her s^d husband and whether she is willing
the said Indenture should be recorded in the Court of our said County and when
you have examined her as aforesaid and taken her acknowledgements of the said
indenture that you distinctly and openly certify us thereof with the said Indenture
