This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> Day of Decr in the Year of  
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty Eight between John Crumpler  
 Solomon Holmes & Jacob Turner of County of Southampton of the one part and William  
 Boykin of the aforesaid County of the other part, (Wilkesboro) the s: John Crumpler  
 Solomon Holmes & Jacob Turner by Decree of the Court of Southampton for and  
 in consideration of the sum of Sixty three pounds, one Shilling & 6 pence Current Money  
 of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said William Boykin at or before the  
 sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Crumpler  
 Solomon Holmes & Jacob Turner with honest acknowledgement thereto  
 to be fully satisfied & paid thereof with clearly account and discharge he &  
 William Boykin his heirs Exec & Assigns by these presents doth give grants  
 bargained sold Enfeoffed & confirmed and by these presents as he give grant bargain  
 sell Enfeoff & confirm unto the said William Boykin his heirs & assigns forever  
 one certain Tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimation Fifty Acres  
 be the same more or less and bounded as followeth vizt beginning at a  
 pine standing at the run of Tarrington swamp so along a line of mark  
 to a pine a corner tree in Leabettone Lanes line from thence a line of Markis trees to a  
 pine standing in the head of a branch called the lone branch so down the s:<sup>d</sup>  
 branch to a pine a corner tree of Leabettone Lanes & Blytha Williams line from  
 thence a line of marked trees to a pine standing at the Run of Tarrington  
 so up the run of the said Tarrington swamp to the first Station with all  
 houses orchards gardens fence Woods underwoods Waters & Water courses & with  
 all profits Commodities advantages Conveniences & appurtenances whatsoever part  
 & parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of land  
 with all and singular the appurtenances unto the said Wm Boykin his  
 heirs & assigns to the only use & behoef of him the said William Boykin  
 forever And the said John Crumpler, Solomon Holmes & Jacob Turner
