Witnesseth that the said Siris Lovell & Sally his wife for and in consideration of the  
sum of Forty Pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said  
William Baykin on or before the sealing & delivering of these presents the Receipt where  
of we the said Siris Lovell & Sally his wife with freely acknowledged hath granted bargained  
and sold unto Arthur Baykin and confirmed by these presents with grants bargains with  
Alters actes and confirmed unto the said William Baykin his heirs & Assigns forever  
one Certain Tract or Parcel of Land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton  
containing by estimation Fifty Eight Acres more or less, and bounded by the lines of  
Arthur Baykin, Leighton Lane, Gibbet Lane, William Baykin & Arthur Baykin  
To have and to hold unto the said William Baykin his heirs and assigns  
forever, also the remainder and remainderies reversion and reversions rents and issues &  
Profits of the said Tract or Parcel of Land to the only people now and hereafter
