 Upshur gentlemen whereas Lord Love & Sally his wife have by their certain indentured
 bargain and sale bearing date the Eleventh day of September. one thousand seven hundred &
 ninety three conveyed unto William Byrd of the County of Southampton the fee simple estate
 of and in Fifty Eight Acres of Land with the appurtenances lying & being in the County of Essex?
 and whereas the said Sally Love cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County to
 acknowledge the same Therefore We do give you my Trust of you Power to receive the acknow-
 ledgement which the said Sally Love shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance
 aforesaid contained in the said indenture which is hereto annexed. And we do hereby command
 you to go personally to the said Sally Love - and Receive her acknowledgement of the same
 and examine her privately and apart from her said husband. Whether she has executed the same
 and freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or threats of her husband and whether
 she is willing for it. In witness whereof should be recorded in the Court of our said County of Southampton
 and when you have examined her as aforesaid & taken her acknowledgement of the said indenture
 that you deliver the original in brief under your hands & seals returning to us also this writ
 With these our Instructions annexed. Witness our hand & Seal the 18th day of the month of August 1793 and the 18th Year of the Commonwealth -

The Court continued & held for the County of Southampton
 the 18th day of February 1794 - This Indenture & the act thereon contained was proved

 fully proved by the Oaths of John Upshur the other Justice of the peace and with the
 Common Pleas full & free examination of Sally Love and the Certificate of the execution
 thereof is now to be recorded
