This Indenture made this 19th day of December one thousand seven hundred & ninety eight between Jacob Vick and Eben Vick of Southampton County, Witnesseth that the said Jacob Vick in consideration of his Father's will hath granted and conveyed and delivered by these presents with grant and confirm forever unto the said Eben Vick his heirs and assigns a Tract of Land containing one hundred and twelve acres beginning at a white oak on the North side of the white oak Branch in John Belvins line thence South forty degrees East forty nine poles to the place of two pines thence North by two hundred & twenty five poles to a red oak in Benjamin Grimes line thence South twenty five degrees west one hundred and twenty poles to a pine thence to the beginning; Together with all houses out houses gardens orchards ways waters coveys woods and uninclosed Mares Horses and all other the profits and commodities thereto belonging and in any now or hereafter to have and to hold the said premises with the appurtenances unto the said Eben Vick his heirs and assigns forever, In Witness whereof the said Jacob Vick hath hereunto set his hand and seal the Day and Year as above
