 Peter Kitcher as give grant and set over and by these presents doth give grant and
 make over to the said Peter Kitcher and his heirs forever all the Lanes and plantation
 Trees Live on containing by estimation one hundred and sixteen Acres more or
 less and bounded as usually known by my Neighbours also I give and do his
 heirs all my Household goods of every Denomination whatsoever together with all my
 stock of every kind and including all and every thing that I am Worthy to this day
 all which I doth give unto him and his heirs forever to the only proper use and belief
 of the said Peter Kitcher and his heirs forever To have and to hold the said premises
 with the appurtenances thereto belonging absolutely without any other manner of Condition
 given under my hand and seal this Twentieth first day of August one Thousand seven
 hundred and ninety Eight.
