taining by estimation six hundred and twenty eight acres
 be the same more or less and late the property of and in
 the tenures of Michael Bobb dec'd and other persons unto
 the said will and Testament of the said Bobb by the
 said Spencer Peers acting Trustee to the said Will and
 bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a corner Post
 oak in Colwin Grays line thence South eighty four degrees
 east twenty one pole to a corner Post oak thence south
 thirty degrees East sixty eight pole thence south twenty
 four degrees east twenty and one half pole to a thirtieth
 in the old road thence south thirty nine degrees east
 twenty six pole; thence south forty nine degrees east
 ninety six pole to a corner red oak standing on the east
 side of the road near an old Pond; thence down the
 said Pond branch the various courses to the Road
 Hills Swamp thence down the various courses of the
 said swamp to a corner pine in Richard Ponds line
