This Indenture made this twenty second day of November
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight
 Between Hardy Poole and wife Sarah of Southampton County of the
 one part and Benjamin Webster of the aforesaid County of the
 other part. Whereas it is agreed between the said Hardy Poole & wife
 for consideration of the sum of two hundred Pounds to them
 in hand paid by the said Benjamin Webster the receipt whereof
 the said Hardy Poole & wife doth hereby acknowledge they the
 said Hardy Poole & wife hath granted bargained and
 sold Allmooe Enfeoffed by these presents doth grant bargeine
 and sold Allmooe enfeoff and confirme unto the said Benjy
 Webster his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or
 parcel of land lying on Notteaway river in Southampton county
 containing by estimation two hundred acres more or less and
 bounded as follows (viz) Beginning at a post pine in John Underwoods line thence 156 a corner pine in Williams
 Woodards line thence along Woodards line to Notteaway River
 thence up said River to a corner Maple in John Under
 woods line thence along underwoods line 1746 a new line
 to the beginning containing two hundred acres more or less it being
 a part of Hardy Poole land which he gave to his son Hardy
 and also all trees woods underwoods commones, Common of Pastures profit and
 uninclosed advantages emblements and hereditaments what
 ever to the said tract or parcel of land above mentioned belong
 ing, or in any wise appertaining out in or upon the same
 growing happening or arising and also the diversion, and
 reversions, remainders, remainders, rents and issues of
 the same premises & of every part thereof and also all the estate
 right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of their
 the said Hardy Poole & wife of in and to said premises for
 part thereof to have and to hold all and singular the
 several premises above mentioned and every part and
 parcel
