This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of June in
 the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety
 eight Between Abraham Jenkins of the county of Southampton
 and Parish of Nottoway of the one part and John Bligh of
 the same county and Parish of the other part Witnesses that
 the said Abraham Jenkins for and in consideration of the just
 and full sum of nine pounds sixteen Shillings and eight
 pence current money of Virginia by the said John Bligh
 to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of
 the presents the receipt whereof the said Abraham Jenkins doth
 hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the
 said John Bligh his heirs and assigns forever and himself
 therewith fully and intirely satisfied contented and paid
 he the said Abraham Jenkins hath granted bargained
 sold aliened enfeoff released let over delivered and confirmed
 and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff
 release let over delivered and confirmed unto the said
 John Bligh and to his heirs and assigns forever all
 that plantation messuage tract and parcel of Land
 whereon I the Abraham Jenkins now lives situated lying
 and being in the county of Southampton and Parish
 of Nottoway aforesaid containing by estimation seven
 acres of land within some more or less and bounded as
 follows to the known and reputed bounds thereof and all the
 houses and houses, edifices, buildings, woods, ways waters,
 and other courses profits, commodities hereditaments and
 appertinances whatsoever to him belonging or in any wise
 appertaining & the reversion and reversions remain and
 remainer with profits and profits thereof and all the
 estate right title interest claim and demand of him
 the said Abraham Jenkins of in and to the same and
 every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the
 said plantation messuage tract and parcel of seven
 five acres of land and premises with all and every
 the appertinances as aforesaid unto him the said
 John Bligh and to his heirs and assigns forever and
 to the only purpose and behoof of him the said John
 John Bligh and to his heirs and assigns forever and the
 said Abraham Jenkins for himself his heirs and assigns
