

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February 1799 the  
Due of Release was acknowledged by John Peagor, Party thereunto Verdict to  
be recorded

Samuel Clark -

This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of September in  
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight  
between John Lewis and Elizabeth Lewis his wife of the County  
of Southampton of the one part and Thomas Gray of the County  
afforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said John  
Lewis and Elizabeth Lewis his wife for and in consideration of  
the sum of Four hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand  
paid by the Thomas Gray the receipt whereof the said John  
Lewis and Elizabeth Lewis his wife do hereby acknowledge  
and thereof and every part thereof doth fully, clearly and  
absolutely acquit exonerate and discharge the said Thomas  
Gray, his heirs Executors and Administrators by these presents &  
and for divers other good causes and considerations then  
truly moving, they the said John Lewis and Elizabeth his wife have  
granted, bargained, sold, aliened, confirmed, and by these presents do  
grant, bargain, sell, alien, and confirm unto the said Thomas  
Gray our certain tract or parcel of land containing by esti-  
mation one hundred and ten acres, situate lying and  
being in the county of Southampton, adjoining the  
lands of Samuel Briggs and others known by the name  
of Spix and being that part of the lands formerly  
the property of Ric. B. Pierce allotted and set apart  
for the proportion of Elizabeth Lewis aforesaid; of the  
lands of her deceas'd father Ric. B. Pierce aforesaid; with  
the reversions, and reversions, Remainder, and Remain-  
der, right Estate Interest Benefits claim and demand  
whatsoever of them the said John Lewis and
