bargain *Debt to John Rose* *Esq*
This Indenture made the eighteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety nine, Between Miles Cary and Elizabeth his wife of the county of Southampton of one part and John Rose of the county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Miles Cary and Elizabeth his for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred pounds lawful money to them in hand paid by the said John Rose the receipt whereof they the said Miles Cary and Elizabeth his wife do hereby acknowledge they the said Miles Cary and Elizabeth his wife have granted bargain sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said John Rose his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the said county of Southampton
